KS1 Big Read!

LITERACY

During RWI sessions children will learn new sounds and practise strategies for reading. In literacy this term children will be looking at stories with a familiar setting and writing non chronological reports. We will be focusing on the books 'Into the Forest' and 'Gorilla' by Anthony Browne.

MATHS

This term we will begin by exploring number and place value. We will mainly focus on what numbers are made of, ordering and comparing numbers and partitioning.

We would be grateful if children could focus on writing and forming numbers correctly up to and over 100.

Grammar

We will begin learning new aspects of grammar and word classes such as adjectives, adverbs, nouns and verbs.

RE

In our circle times we will discuss the below values stated in the SMSC box.

PE

Our focus this term will be dance. Children will explore ways of travelling using their body and creating sequences of movements.

Science

We will be focusing on the needs of humans to survive in their habitat. We will also look at various habitats around us and how they meet the needs of the animals that live in them.
