



Key Areas of Learning

As **Historians** we will explore the development of NASA and the importance of space exploration, creating diary entries and reflecting on the impact space exploration has had on us today.

As **Scientists** we will develop our knowledge and understanding of the solar system through the exploration of space missions, planets and creating our own models of the solar system

As **Artists** we will further developing our art techniques by using a range of mediums to create Mars pictures and other artworks.

LITERACY

In Literacy this term children will develop their story-telling and writing skills through the story of *Pandora's Box*. This myth will teach about the consequences of decision making.
